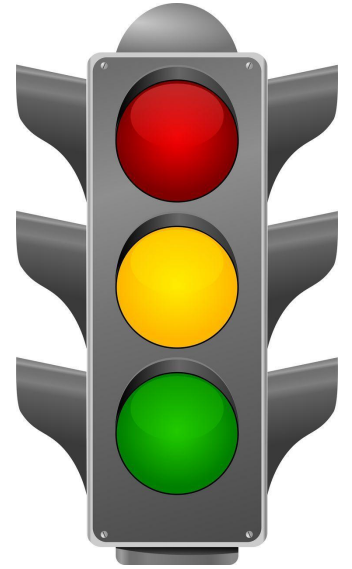
Survey Results - Summary

- **5-Way Traffic Light & Crosswalk Installation**

- 428 Respondents (All addresses validated as Larchmont Edgewater)
- 58% Not in Support of Moving Forward with the Project
- 35% In support of moving forward
- 19% Indifferent
- 17% Need more information

- **Jamestown Crescent Speeding Concerns**

- 58% In favor of a City of Norfolk Jamestown Crescent traffic study to address speeding

Survey Intro

At our February 27th civic league meeting, the City of Norfolk, Department of Transportation briefed the plan to reinstall a traffic light at the intersection of Hampton Blvd, Jamestown Cres, Hanover Ave, and Richmond Cres (July 2023 - July 2024). A traffic light previously existed at this intersection. A more tech-capable five-point traffic light is funded for re-installation. Some expressed concerns about the reinstallation and side-street traffic effects while others voiced support for increased safety for vehicles and pedestrians navigating Hampton Blvd. Some also shared concerns about the increase in speeding along Jamestown Cres.

This brief 4-section survey will inform city leadership and support data-driven decision-making. Sections 2 through 4 include a comments block. Results will also be shared via our newsletter and Facebook page (without attribution). We're asking all Larchmont Edgewater residents (only) who are 18 years or older to complete this survey no later than noon on March 24th, 2023. Please share this with your Larchmont Edgewater neighbors.

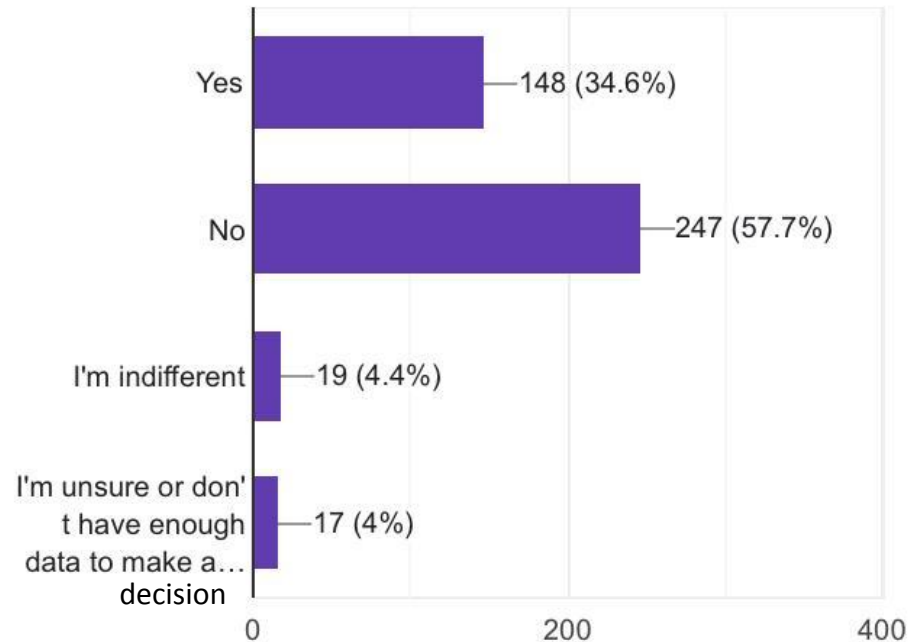

Are you generally in favor of the city's approved and budgeted plan to move forward with reinstalling the traffic light?



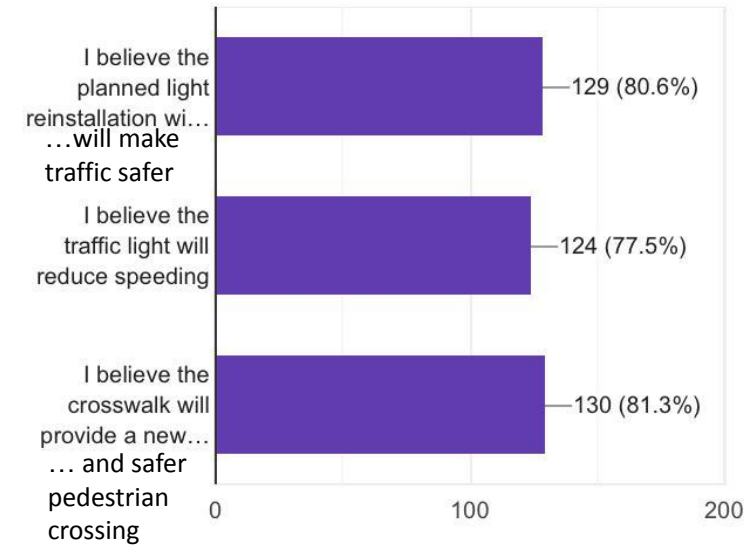

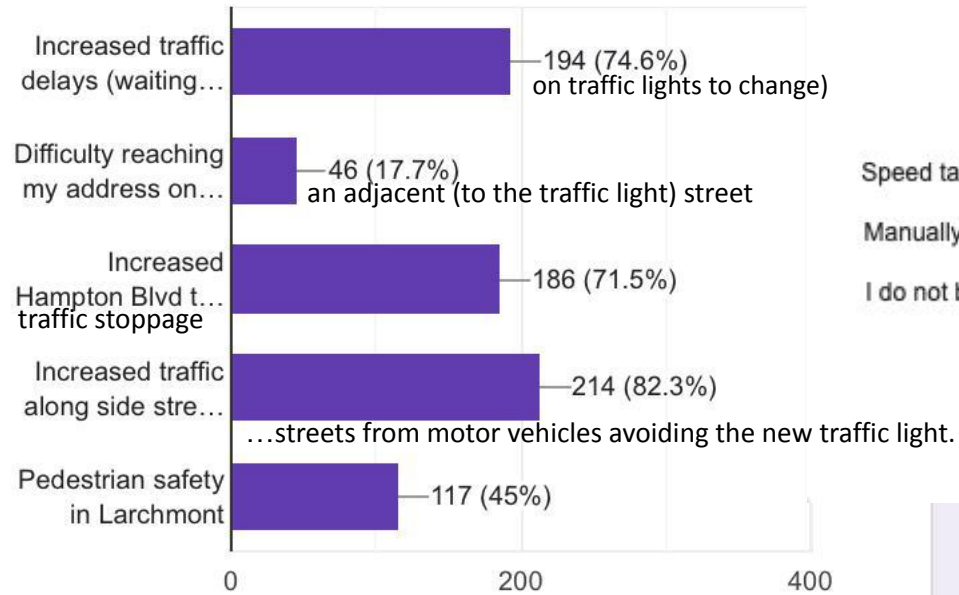


Section 3: Traffic Light Reinstallation Mitigations
